What exactly is the Transparency in Coverage - Public Access Requirement?

The Public Access Requirement requires that group health plans and issuers must make three separate machine-readable files (MRF) publicly available, free of charge, by July 1, 2022.

- The files are updated monthly and include the following detailed pricing information:
 - In network: Negotiated rates for all covered items and services between the plan or issuer and in-network providers.
 - Out of network: Historical payments to, and billed charges from, outof-network providers. Files are not required if there are fewer than 20 claims for a service or a provider.
 - Prescription drugs: In-network negotiated rates and historical net prices for all covered prescription drugs at the pharmacy location level (this requirement is delayed).
- Purpose of the machine-readable files (MRF)
 - To provide raw data in a specific machine-readable format
 - This is a step that lays the groundwork for a consumer-facing experience, powered by this data, to inform employee decision making.
