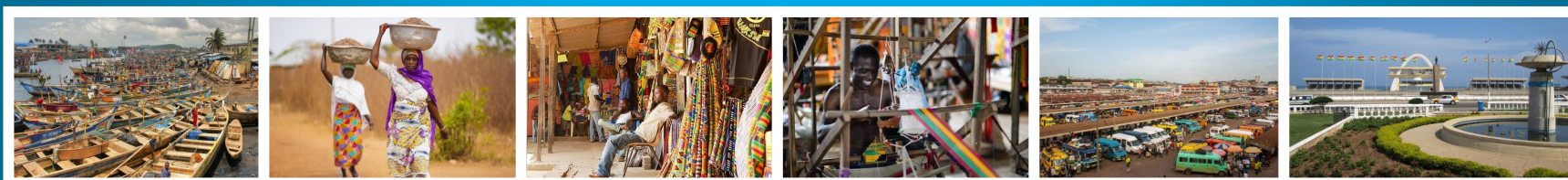
With Study Tour to Ghana
