Official Graduate Record Examination (GRE) (general exam) scores must be sent directly from the Educational Testing Service and must be received at Puget Sound by the December 15 secondary application deadline. The GRE must not be taken more than five years prior to planned enrollment in the physical therapy program.

A non-refundable \$25 Secondary Application Fee is required from Doctor of Physical Therapy applicants.

All prerequisite coursework must be taken for a grade. Pass/Fail coursework is not acceptable. The University of Puget Sound evaluator verifies equivalency for each prerequisite course. If you have completed or plan to complete any of the required prerequisite coursework at a school outside the State of Washington, you are required to attach a course description or course syllabus for each course. You may cut and paste the course description in electronic form from your university catalog. If this is not possible, please mail to the Office of Admission, University of Puget Sound, 1500 North Warner Street #1062, Tacoma, WA 98416-1062 or fax to 253.879.3993. The supporting course information must indicate laboratory verification.

In general, prerequisite courses should be completed no more than 10 years before entry into the program. If a longer time has elapsed, the applicant should submit a letter addressed to the Office of Admission, University of Puget Sound, 1500 North Warner Street #1062, Tacoma, WA 98416-1062, explaining how the knowledge has been kept current.

You must earn a grade of at least 2.0 in each prerequisite course. The cumulative prerequisite GPA must be at least 3.0.

Puget Sound Course or Equivalent:

Anatomy and Physiology; comparative or vertebrate acceptable, human preferred (Puget Sound EXSC 221/222) with labs. (Combined credit value = 8 semester credits / 2 Puget Sound units.)

Physics (Puget Sound PHYS 111/112) with labs. (Combined credit value = 8 semester credits / 2 Puget Sound units.)

Chemistry (Puget Sound CHEM 110/111) with labs. (Combined credit value = 8 semester credits / 2 Puget Sound units.)

Statistics (Puget Sound MATH 271). (Combined credit value = 4 semester credits / 1 Puget Sound unit.)

One course in general psychology (Puget Sound PSYC 101), abnormal psychology (Puget Sound PSYC 295), or sociology (Puget Sound CSOC 206 or CSOC 370) emphasizing human behavior or disability issues. (Combined credit value = 4 semester credits / 1 Puget Sound unit.)

Note: The number of lines completed under "Requirements" below may need to be increased or decreased depending upon your specific coursework.
