<p style="text-align: center;"><b>PREREQUISITES FOR ADMISSION TO THE ENTRY-LEVEL GRADUATE PROGRAM IN OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY</b></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>PREREQUISITES FOR ADMISSION TO THE DOCTOR OF PHYSICAL THERAPY PROGRAM</b></p>
<p>Students must have a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university and may prepare for Occupational Therapy while pursuing any major course of study. Some majors may be designed as pre-Occupational Therapy, but students are cautioned to not assume that programs designed as such will necessarily benefit their application.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Anatomy and Physiology, preferably with labs: EXSC 221 and EXSC 222 or equivalent.</li> <li>2. Human Development/Human Behavioral Science: a total of three courses, distributed as follows: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A. Human Development through the life span: PSYC 220 and PSYC 221 or equivalent. <p>Note: It is possible to complete the Human Development prerequisite within a single course covering the life span. In this case, students must complete 2 courses in category (B) listed below:</p> </li> <li>B. Human Behavioral Science: course(s) in Anthropology, Psychology, or Sociology at the 200-level or above (except where noted) addressing at least <b>one of the following content areas</b>: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. Normal and abnormal behavior of individuals and/or groups;</li> <li>ii. The analysis of behavior of individuals and/or groups and their interactions;</li> <li>iii. Culture and mental health.</li> </ol> </li> </ol> </li> <li>3. Elements of Applied Statistics: MATH 160 or PSYC 201 and PSYC 301 or equivalent.</li> </ol> <p>All prerequisite courses must be taken for a letter grade, and students must earn at least a "C" (2.0) in each course. A minimum 3.00 cumulative undergraduate grade point average or a grade point average above 3.25 for the last 2 years of academic work is also required for admission.</p>	<p>Students must have a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university and may prepare for Physical Therapy while pursuing any major course of study. Some majors may be designed as pre-Physical Therapy, but students are cautioned to not assume that programs designed as such will necessarily benefit their application.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Human Anatomy and Physiology (laboratories must be included): EXSC 221 and EXSC 222 or equivalent.</li> <li>2. General College Physics (laboratories must be included): PHYS 111 and PHYS 112 or equivalent.</li> <li>3. Fundamental Chemistry (laboratories must be included): CHEM 110 and CHEM 111 or equivalent.</li> <li>4. Elements of Applied Statistics: MATH 160 or PSYC 201 and PSYC 301 or equivalent.</li> <li>5. One course in psychology or sociology emphasizing human behavior or disability. Puget Sound courses that fulfill the requirement include PSYC 101 Introduction to Psychology; PSYC 320 Psychological Disorders; CSOC 206 Deviance and Social Control; or CSOC 370 Disability, Identity, and Power.</li> </ol> <p>Prerequisite courses should be completed within 10 years of entry into the program. If a longer time has elapsed, the applicant must submit a letter explaining how the knowledge has been kept current.</p> <p>All prerequisite courses must be taken for a letter grade, and students must earn at least a "B" (3.0) grade in each course. Because course content can be divided into specific courses in different ways, the faculty highly recommends that each science prerequisite course sequence be completed at a single college or university. Questions about prerequisite course equivalencies should be directed in writing to the Office of Admission, accompanied by a course description including the name of the school and an unofficial transcript of the coursework completed. Only written inquiries will be answered. Prior to submission of the application for admission, all evaluations are unofficial. In addition, unofficial evaluations are completed only between May 1 and October 1.</p>
