- 4) ARTS 347 is taken in tandem with ARTS 447. If you take ARTS 347 during your junior year, it is strongly recommended to enroll in ARTS 447 your senior year. If you do not enroll in ARTS 347 during your junior year, you may take it in your senior year.
- 5) Of the three units of upper division coursework required outside the first major, the Connections course will count for one unless it is used to meet a major requirement.
- 6) Additional ART courses are suggested for the senior year.
