The *One More* scholarship was created in 2014 by the Black Student Union of Puget Sound in order to alleviate some of the barriers to pursuing higher education for fellow students of color by providing financial support. *One More* is an additive scholarship that provides funding for books and technology to include textbooks, first purchase laptop or computer, or other classroom necessities available at Puget Sound.

Award amounts vary depending upon number of recipients and class year. Previous recipients are eligible to apply, however priority is given to new applicants. Scholarship recipients are expected to actively participate in the Black Student Union throughout the academic year.

Eligible recipients are incoming or currently enrolled Puget Sound students for the 2016-17 year who demonstrate financial need, and have a 3.0 GPA.
