NOTES:

- 1) ECON 170 is a prerequisite for BUS 310 & 315.
- 2) BUS 205 and MATH 160 or 260 are prerequisites for BUS 315.
- 3) Recommend BUS 315 the semester following BUS 205.
- 4) Courses used to satisfy the BUS elective requirement may not also be used to satisfy university core requirements. BUS 300, 344 and CONN 387, 390, 478 may not be used to fulfill this requirement.
- 5) Students must complete the foundational courses and have senior standing before taking the senior research seminar. Check course descriptions, as well as semester by semester course offerings, for 400-level BUS classes to determine if they fulfill the Senior Research Seminar requirement. Courses approved: BUS 416, 432, 476, 478, 482, 485.
- 6) Of the three units of upper division coursework required outside the first major, the Connections course will count for one.
