NOTES:

Puget Sound requires a total of 32 units to graduate

- 1) Foundations: ENGL 220 and three courses from ENGL 221-249.
- 2) Constructing Knowledge: Four (4) courses from ENGL 321-389. Students must have completed ENGL_220 and at least one other 200-level requirement to register for courses at the 300 level.
- 3) Senior Seminars: Two (2) courses from ENGL 430-497. Students must have completed all 200-level requirements toward the major and a minimum of two courses at the 300 level before registering for a senior experience seminar. Senior Seminars require appropriate preparation and permission of instructor.

*Of the three units of upper division coursework required outside the first major, the Connections course will count for one unless it is used to meet a major requirement.
