NOTES:

- 1) The one additional Theatre Arts Major Elective Requirement must be a THTR course (not THTR 200) such as a 3rd acting course, THTR 306 Playwriting, THTR Seminar course, Independent Study, etc., or MUS 220.
- 2) THTR 371 and 373 may be taken at any point after taking a World Theatre class (THTR 250, 252, 254, or 256). The junior year is recommended, but the courses may be taken in the sophomore or senior years.
- 3) Of the three units of upper division coursework required outside the first major, the Connections course will count for one unit unless it is used to meet a major requirement.
