**Business electives ( 2 units) at 300-400 level (excluding BUS 300, 316, and 344; CONN 387, 390, and 478). Courses used to satisfy the Business elective and senior research seminar requirements may not also be used to satisfy university core requirements.
***Students must complete the foundation courses and have senior standing before taking the Senior Research Seminar. Courses approved: BUS 432, 476, 478, 482, and 485. Courses used to satisfy this requirement may not also be used to satisfy the Business Elective or the university core requirements.
All business majors much select and meet with a Business faculty advisor.
