NOTES:

Business Leadership Program students must maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 in all university work. Only courses for which the student has received a C or better count for the major. In addition, students must earn a grade of C- or better in all prerequisite courses.

- 1) BUS 205, ECON 101, and MATH 160 or 260 are prerequisites for BUS 315.
- 2) Students must register for cohort BLP sections of ECON 101, MATH 160 (unless taking 260), BUS 305, 310, 315, 340, and 385.
- 3) Students must complete the foundational courses and have senior standing before taking the senior research seminar. Check course descriptions, as well as semester by semester course offerings, for 400-level BUS classes to determine if they fulfill the Senior Research Seminar requirement. Courses approved: BUS 432, 476, 478, 482, and 485.
- 4) Of the three units of upper division coursework required outside the first major, the Connections course will count for one.
