One course. See Bulletin for details. Courses may also fulfill other program or graduation requirements.

NOTES

- 1) Entrance audition required for acceptance to the major.
- 2) Only courses in which a C- or better is earned will count toward the major.
- 3) Four units of Musicology/Ethnomusicology to include MUS 233, 234, and two additional Musicology/Ethnomusicology electives, one of which must be 300+.
- 4) Minimum of 1.5 units to be chosen from: MUS 168/368 (0.5 maximum), 235, 236, 237, 238, 250, 301, 335, 337, 338, 341, 354, 355, 390, 392, 393, 394, 401, 402, 437, 438; HUM 315, 316; or a 200+ level musicol/ethnomus course; a maximum of 0.5 unit in applied lessons in a secondary instrument, with music faculty advisor approval. Music majors must attain, maintain membership in, attend, and be registered for credit in the appropriate music ensemble every semester they are enrolled. Jazz Band qualifies as a primary ensemble for keyboard majors.
- 5) To advance to the junior year and graduate in the major, a student must have a 2.3 overall grade point average, a 2.5 music grade point average, and demonstrate excellence in the jury of their major performance instrument in the spring jury of their sophomore year.
- 6) Music majors must register for Recital Attendance every semester they are in residence (MUS 109 as freshmen and sophomores; MUS 309 as juniors and seniors).
- 7) Music 234 satisfies the Artistic Approaches core.
- 8) Students wishing to study abroad are encouraged to do so in the spring semester of their junior year.
