This document is intended to serve as a quick guide to the university's internal grants, sabbatical leave opportunities, and workshops & conversations. The committee continued to work on Senate charge #4, to synchronize and streamline the student application processes for summer research and UEC-funded research. Our purpose is to facilitate UEC funding for students who need it in order to carry out their summer research. Guided by Luc, the UEC members compared the parallel language on the two forms and made suggestions for further editing.

Luc reported that one of the two students assigned to the UEC was unsure about what was expected, and the other assigned student has been non-responsive to communication. We will attempt to recruit at least one student to join the UEC in time for its next meeting, when we will consider student research proposals.
