Students must earn a grade of C (2.0) or above in all courses taken for a major or minor in the German Studies Department.

- 1) Can be substituted by units from the successful completion of higher level German courses.
- 2) Satisfies Humanistic Approaches core requirement.
- 3) At least four additional units from the following: GERM 300, 305, 310, 315, 365, 395, 420, 450, 480; CONN 330, 333; HIST 224, 317, 320, 322, 325, 335; P&G 321. At least one of these units, but no more than two units, must come from GERM or CONN 330.
- 4) At least one semester in an immersion study abroad program in Germany, Austria, or Switzerland (with one year strongly recommended) or on a program in an Eastern European country that includes courses in the foreign language at some level (including Elementary). See bulletin for additional options if financial or personal circumstances preclude a student from studying abroad.

*Of the three units of upper division coursework required outside the first major, the Connections course will count for one unless it is used to meet a major requirement.

**A senior paper to be completed during a seminar course (GERM 400+) in senior year.

***Due April 15 of senior year. Student to seek guidance from a Faculty Advisor on creating a portfolio as soon as they declare their major.
