- 2) Six additional history electives, at least four of the six at the 300 and 400 levels.
- 3) Of the three units of upper division coursework required outside the first major, the Connections course will count for one unless it is used to meet a major requirement.

Excluding HIST 200 and 400, the major must include:

- at least one unit in each in three of the following five areas of history: African, Asian, European, Latin American, and United States history.
- at least one unit of ancient/medieval/early modern history, chosen from the following: HIST 101, 112, 230, 245, 280, 293, 302, 305, 307, 311, 314, 351, 352; CLSC 210, 211, 212, 320.

Seminars in Scholarly Inquiry offered by the History Department do not count toward either the History major or minor.
