Foreign Language Requirement (circle one)

Upper Division Level Requirement

For students with a major in science (any major in Biology, Chemistry, Exercise Science, Geology, Physics, and Psychology departments, including the Natural Science majors), only one scientific elective may count unless special exception is granted from the Advisory Committee.
