Minutes of the Professional Standards Committee October 23, 2006

Share convened the meeting at 3:05 p.m.

The minutes from the previous meeting will be approved next time.

Dean Bartanen asked that the committee consider standards for early tenure this year.

Communication Studies evaluation standards are still under review by their subcommittee.

Politics and Government evaluation standards have been approved as revised.

PSC returned to a discussion about departmental evaluation guidelines. It was noted that department evaluation standard documents differ in their procedures, as was illustrated by some further research done by one PSC member into the variations in departmental evaluation standards.

The PSC then continued its deliberations on the Foreign Language and Literature evaluation guidelines.

The PSC then considered whether individual department guidelines should define procedures. The Code states that departments should establish "criteria" and "standards" but does not specify setting different procedures. The terms "criteria" and "standards" were defined by one PSC member as "what?" and "how much?" respectively. Two possibilities were floated initially: either the PSC could send its concerns about this issue to the Senate, or the PSC could issue a formal interpretation of the Code.

It was decided to return to this question next week, along with a discussion of the Education and Communications Studies evaluation standards.

The meeting was adjourned at 3:57pm.
