- 1. The minutes of the meetings on February 6, 2004, and March 5, 2004, were approved.
- 2. Announcements: Karen Fischer announced that the library is sponsoring a student art award. Peter Greenfield announced that there would be one more meeting in two weeks, on April 30, at which Michael Nanfito will discuss cataloging digital media.
- 3. Electronic classrooms (handout). Norman Imamshah announced that ten classrooms were budgeted originally over five years, but we will be able to complete them over the next three to four years. Many members of the committee praised this proactive move, which is in anticipation of the growing desire for electronic classrooms.
