## Professional Standards Committee Minutes October 16, 2003

The committee discussed the prioritization of a list of agenda items distributed by Stirling.

In response to a faculty inquiry, the committee affirmed that:

- a) a deadline for submission of written material means that hard copy must be submitted by the close of the working day (5 pm).
- b) for counting days to a deadline, Fall Break Day, Spring Break, and holidays (closure of the University) are considered non-working days. Reading Period and Final Exam days are working days.
- c) The clear intent of the "or" (Faculty Code, Chpt. III section 4b, last paragraph) referring to "the right to pursue those concerns (1) informally <u>or</u> (2) formally" is inclusive. Both the informal and formal routes are available.

Issues b) and c) will be the subjects of further discussion and clarification in the future.
