- 4. Matt and John talked about the pros and cons of the laptop tablet. The handwriting recognition features of the ACER tablet were especially good. Pen navigation was easier than expected. It has no drives, and therefore will require external drives to be fully functional as a laptop. It is more portable than the Smart Board which is permanently installed at the podium and since it is very portable and attractive it will need to be secured if it is placed in electronic classrooms. The tablet is not a substitute for the Smart Board or for a laptop.
- 5. Bill announced that there will be three more electronic classrooms with permanently mounted data projectors in Wyatt 204, McIntyre 103 and Jones 203. These will be ready for classes in fall.
- 6. Bill also announced the schedule of Technology and Teaching Workshops for Summer 2003, as follows:
