Pat Krueger called the meeting to order at 9:05 am.

Announcements:

- -Wednesday, February 28: interview with Freida Savage for the "Access to College" position.
- **-Krueger**: "Yes" from BTF on \$10,000 for minority faculty hiring, Access to College position, and athletic related financial aid directed toward ethnic minority student financial aid; "No" on \$10,000 curricular development of ethnic minorities incentive and DC fund for member development.

The rest of the hour was devoted to the discussion of **Hansen's** "Proposal For a High-Level African-American Administrator". The "problem-solution" framework of the paper was appreciated and many comments about the philosophy of how change for diversity is accomplished surfaced. Those included:

- -DC operates on a cycle of conception and death of work; a chanage is needed.
- -There is good support from Human Resources in faculty and administrative hiring.
- -Curricular changes have occurred over the last 20 years from within due to faculty hiring.
- -Position of diversity boosts that particular area.
- -This position may help achieve the "critical mass" needed to improve the numbers; a 7-10 year position could achieve this, then integrate concepts and techniques into departments and University in general.
- -Growth from inside: Access to College position has grown into broader responsibilities; the "organic solution" to "growth by substitution".
- -Suggestion that the Access to College position be evaluated annually in terms of resonsibilities and effectiveness.
- -Delineate responsibilities of position and pass on to Faculty Senate.
- -A current Access to College position description will be sent by Gibson.
- -The path of the final report should be: Faculty Senate; BTF in Fall '96; implementation in '97-'98.

By consensus the report was received and discussion will continue.
