Replace the terms Òcareer and non-career facultyÓ (Riegsecker).

The committee examined the proposed motions to amend the Faculty Bylaws and the Faculty Code by replacing Òcareer-facultyÓ with Òtenure-line facultyÓ and Ònon-career facultyÓ with Ònon-tenure-lineÓ faculty. The use of the terms career and non-career in the appendices and interpretations by the Professional Standards would be addressed by footnotes.
