

**UNIVERSITY ENRICHMENT COMMITTEE
REPORT TO THE FACULTY SENATE
MAY 6, 1996**

1. Reviewed applications by both faculty and students for travel and research funds. Decisions were made and funds were disbursed.
2. Requested and received additional support (\$5,000) for student research fund from Budget Task Force, beginning 1996-97.
3. Discussed with Raney Ellis a need for additional laptop computers for faculty use. In response, he graciously provided four machines. Revised guidelines for use of a total of six machines.
4. Changed deadline for first trip proposals from May 1 to July 1 in order to maximize distribution of first trip travel money.
5. Revised language in "Conference Participation" and "Pedagogy Travel Grant" guidelines so as to close a loophole facilitating the possibility of two first trip fundings.
6. Reviewed and endorsed recommendations for UEC by the Ad Hoc Committee on Governance.
7. Selected D. Wade Hands as the 1996-97 Dirk Andrew Phibbs Scholar.
8. Selected William Breitenbach as the 1997 Regester Lecturer.
9. Returned the Regester Lectureship to an annual event.
10. In the process of revising and clarifying guidelines for nomination and selection of the Regester Lecturer (final meeting May 10, 1996).
