<p>CHWS considers applicants from APA or CPA accredited training programs in counseling or clinical psychology. Applicants must be in good standing with their academic department, must have defended dissertation proposal and passed comprehensive exams by the application deadline. Applicants should be prepared to work with clients presenting with moderate psychopathology and to see clients presenting with a wide range of clinical diagnoses (ex: mood and anxiety disorders, interpersonal or personality disorder traits, trauma or abuse recovery, eating disorder and body image disturbance, alcohol and other drug use concerns, identity issues including sexual orientation, gender identity, cultural identity, etc.). Applicants must be comfortable working with a diverse clientele in an agency with a commitment to social justice. Applicants will work with a multidisciplinary team in a combined counseling and health clinic. College counseling experience is preferred, but not required. Successful applicants with whom we match must complete and pass a background check and must comply with the university requirement for COVID 19 vaccination.</p>
