



**Black Student Union, *One More* Scholarship  
2022-23 Academic Year**

**Submit completed applications to Student Financial Services (Jones 019) by March 31, 2022**

The *One More* scholarship was created in 2014 by the Black Student Union of Puget Sound in order to alleviate some of the barriers to pursuing higher education for fellow students of color by providing financial support. *One More* is an additive scholarship that provides funding for books and technology to include textbooks, first purchase laptop, or other classroom necessities available at Puget Sound.

While the exact scholarship amount has yet to be determined, in the past we have awarded 6-10 scholarships with an average amount of \$500 per student. Previous recipients are eligible to apply, however priority is given to new applicants. Previous recipients must submit a new application each year. Scholarship recipients are expected to actively participate in the Black Student Union throughout the academic year.

Eligible recipients are current Puget Sound students who will be enrolled for the 2022-23 year and demonstrate financial need with an emphasis on applicants who identify as Black and/or African American (including biracial and multiracial black students).
