Formed in 1900, the University of Puget Sound Women's League is a community of supporters whose mission is to provide scholarships to students, supporting their educational goals. There are three endowed scholarship funds:

The Thompson Scholarship - In 1974, the Dr. Franklin & Lucille Thompson Scholarship was established to honor Dr. Franklin and Lucille Thompson. Dr. Franklin Thompson was president of Puget Sound for 31 years, from 1942 to 1973. His wife, Lucille Thompson, was very involved in the Women's League. She served in nearly every officer position and helped the League make contributions to each of the buildings which were built during her husband's presidency. Up to four \$3,200 Thompson Scholarships will be awarded to sophomores or juniors who demonstrate academic merit, financial need, and participate in extracurricular activities.

The Women's League Scholarship - Established in 1982 to provide scholarships to students with financial need. Up to five \$3,200 scholarships will be awarded to students with junior class standing who demonstrate academic merit, financial need, and participate in extracurricular activities.

The Centennial Scholarship Fund - Established in 1987 in recognition of the Centennial of the university. Awards are made to female students who demonstrate financial need. First preference is given to women who are over the age of 35 and are from Pierce County. While the number of scholarships has yet to be determined, in the past we have awarded 2-3 scholarships with an average amount of \$3,500 per student.
