



Attach a 2–3-page double spaced essay that includes the following:

1. Identifies your chosen scientific and humanistic fields. Describes your interest in pursuing the interdisciplinary relationship between these two fields of study.
2. Outlines a plan of study for the pursuit of the relevant interdisciplinary interests that includes at least two courses (for example one in the sciences and one in a humanistic discipline). One or both of these courses can be interdisciplinary, if relevant. Explain how each course relates to your interdisciplinary interests and how you will relate them to each other.
3. If you have received an earlier Collier Scholarship, your essay should indicate how your earlier plans have evolved and borne fruit.
