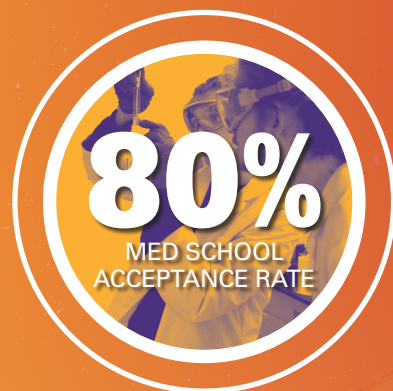


SAM LILLY
