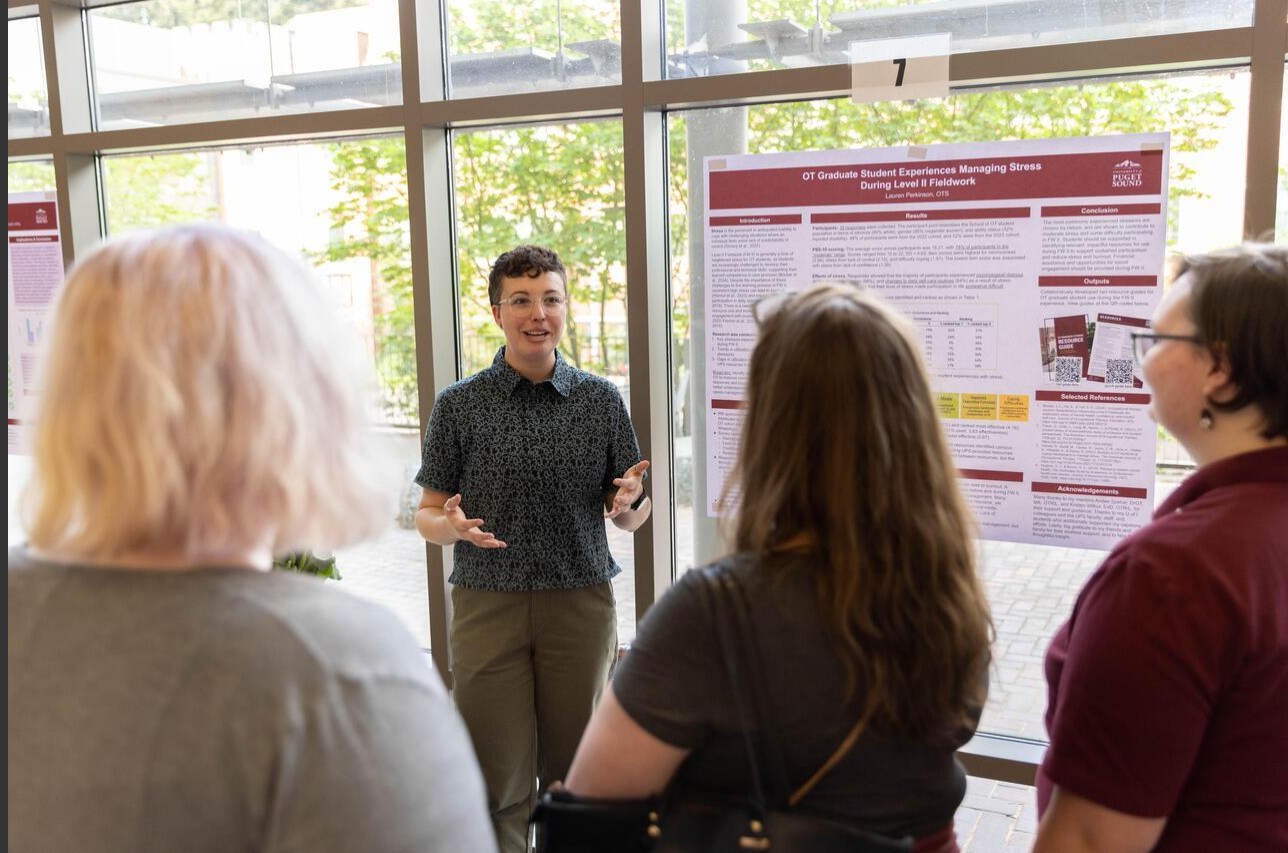

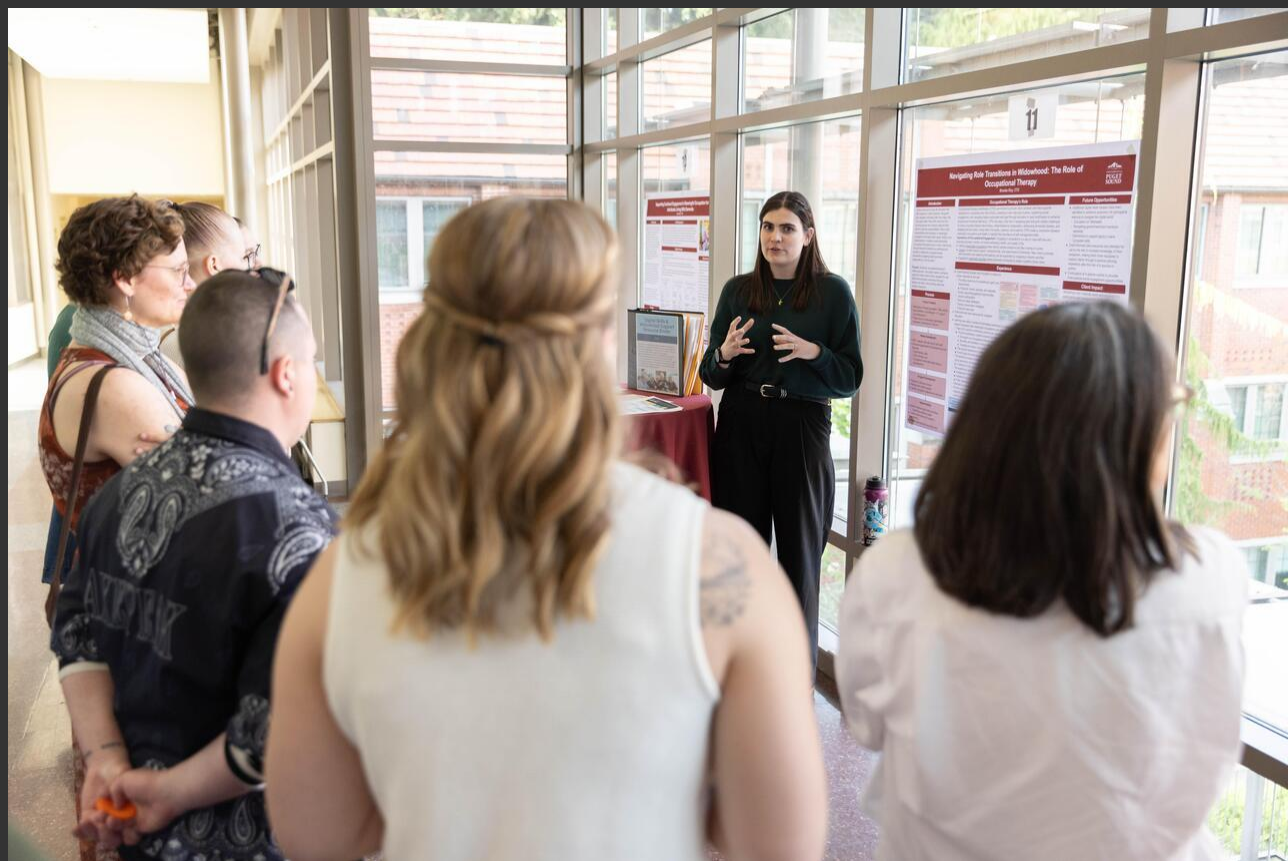


The Dr. George Tomlin Evidence Symposium
