I will be completely moved out by, and I will leave the unit in the same or better condition than it was when I moved in, minus normal wear and tear. I will be entitled to a full refund of my deposit, and a pro-rated refund of any prepaid, unused rent. Please send \$ without delay to my new address:
If I haven't heard from you within fourteen days after I have moved out, the landlord-tenant act allows me to sue you for twice the amount of my deposit, plus a pro-rated refund of any prepaid rent, and any and all court costs and attorney fees.
