BIOE/REL 292 or BIOE/PHIL 292 may be taken either fall or spring semesters and may be taken as early as first semester freshman year. This course is generally offered every semester and may be taken through junior year, although it is the basic gateway course to the Bioethics program.

\*\*\*Three elective units at the 200-level or above drawn from at least two of the three elective categories: Scientific, Ethical, and Humanities & Social Sciences. See Bulletin for list of elective options from each category.
