2) Four units of Japanese culture, of which at least two must be at the 300 level or above, taken on the Tacoma campus. Of the four, at least three must be chosen from the following courses: ALC 310, 320, 330, ARTH 368; HIST 248; PG 372; REL 233, 300, 328; SOAN 304. An additional unit may be chosen from the following courses: ALC 205; ARTH 278, 370, 371; ASIA 341; HIST 349; HUM 330, 335; PG 323; REL 332.
3) Of the three units of upper division coursework required outside the first major, the Connections course will count for one unless it is used to meet a major requirement.
