**ECON 101 is a prerequisite for BUS 310. ECON 101 also satisfies the SL core.

#Math 160 is recommended, not required; satisfies Mathematical Approaches core requirement.

- 1) Entrance audition required for acceptance to the major.
- 2) Only courses in which a C- or better is earned will count toward the major.
- 3) Music majors must maintain membership and registration for credit in the music ensemble appropriate to their primary instrument every semester they are in residence. Jazz Band may qualify as a major ensemble in keyboard or guitar.
- 4) To advance to the junior year, a student must have a 2.3 overall grade point average, a 2.5 music grade point average, and demonstrate excellence in the jury of their major performance instrument in the spring jury of the sophomore year.
- 5) Music majors must register for Recital Attendance every semester they are in residence.
- 6) Students wishing to study abroad are encouraged to do so in the spring semester of their junior year, unless it conflicts with MUS 341, which currently is offered every other year.
