### **NOTES**

- 1) Entrance audition required for acceptance to the major.
- 2) Minimum of 1.5 units of music electives to be chosen from: MUS 168/368 (0.5 maximum), 220, 221, 222, 223, 235, 236, 250, 301, 335, 337, 341, 354, 355, 390, 392, 393, 394, 401, 402, 437, 493, 494; HUM 315, 316; a maximum of 0.5 unit in applied lessons in a secondary instrument, with music advisor approval.
- 3) Only courses in which a C- or better is earned will count toward the major.
- 4) Music majors must attain, maintain membership in, attend, and be registered for credit in the appropriate music ensemble every semester they are enrolled. Jazz Band qualifies as a primary ensemble for keyboard majors.
- 5) To advance to the junior year and graduate in the major, a student must have a 2.3 overall grade point average, a 2.5 music grade point average, and demonstrate excellence in the jury of their major performance instrument in the spring jury of their sophomore year.
- 6) Music majors must register for Recital Attendance every semester they are in residence (MUS 109 as freshmen and sophomores; MUS 309 as juniors and seniors).
- 7) Music 230 satisfies the Artistic Approaches core.
- 8) Students wishing to study abroad are encouraged to do so in the spring semester of their junior year.
