NOTES

- 1) Entrance audition required for acceptance into the major.
- 2) 1 unit of Music Electives to be chosen from: MUS 168, 368 (.5 unit maximum), 220, 221, 222, 301, 335, 337, 341, 390, 392, 393, 394, 401, 402, 493, 494, HUM 316; a maximum of .5 unit in applied lessons in a secondary instrument.
- 3) Two units of a foreign language required to meet national accreditation requirements for the degree.
- 4) Only courses in which a C- or better is earned will count toward the major.
- Music majors must maintain membership and registration for credit in a vocal music ensemble every semester they are in residence.
- 6) To advance to the junior year, a student must have a 2.3 overall grade point average, a 2.5 music grade point average, and demonstrate excellence in the jury of their major performance instrument in the spring jury of the sophomore year.
- 7) Music majors must register for Recital Attendance every semester they are in residence. (MUS 109 as freshmen and sophomores; MUS 309 as juniors and seniors.)
- 8) MUS 230 satisfies the Artistic Approaches core.
- 9) Students wishing to study abroad are encouraged to do so in the spring semester of their junior year.
