- 1) These two courses fulfil major requirements and may be used to fulfill university core requirements (SL and HM cores, respectively). Majors may satisfy no more than two University core requirements from Sociology and Anthropology offerings.
- 2) MATH 160 strongly recommended as prerequisite. Fulfils MA core.
- 3) Students <u>must</u> complete SOAN 101, 102, 295 or 296, 298 and 299 before taking Senior Thesis (SOAN 490). It is particularly important for students planning to study abroad to be certain that these courses are completed before enrolling in SOAN 490.
- 4) Of the three units of upper-division coursework required outside the first major, the Connections course will count for one unless it is used to meet a major requirement.
- *Ideally, SOAN 299 could and should be taken in the sophomore year before potential study abroad. SOAN 298 does not have to be completed prior to taking SOAN 299. Speak with your SOAN advisor or the department chair for further advising.
- **The year-long Senior Thesis version **requires** SOAN 490A and SOAN 491. If the two-semester thesis option is selected (original, social research project), SOAN 491 counts as an upper-division SOAN elective course; The one-semester version requires SOAN 490B (offered in the Spring only).
